Add Pictures – see video tutorial: <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4GGpUxfuVU>

- Open Notebook and Internet Explorer
- Navigate to a page where all you see is the picture
- Holding the mouse button down, drag the image down to Notebook on the taskbar,
- and then up onto the page
- Release the mouse button
- Once the image is in Notebook, drag it to MY CONTENT in the Gallery
- Edit its properties to give it a name and search keywords

Add Flash Video (FLV)

- TeacherTube – automatically downloads to FLV
- YouTube – Internet Explorer – use <http://keepvid.com> or <http://safevid.com> to download to FLV
- YouTube – Firefox – use DownloadHelper – <http://www.downloadhelper.net>

SMART Notebook will recognize more than just flash video by installing multiple encoders

SMART Board Instructions

Downloading FLASH Video Files from YouTube (or other video sharing sites)

INTERNET EXPLORER

1. Go to the page where the video is playing and copy the URL
- right-click on the URL
- then click copy
2. Go to www.keepvid.com
3. Paste the URL in the blue box
4. Click the download button
5. After the site reloads, right-click the green Download link for the flv option, select "save target as" and save the file to your desktop

You can now drag the file onto a page in SMART Notebook

FIREFOX

1. Go to <https://addons.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/addon/3006>
2. Click the green "Add to Firefox" button to install
3. Go to the page where the video is playing. Next to the URL you will see the downloader helper icon with small arrow.
4. Click the small arrow and select the FLV option to download and save the FLV file to your desktop

You can now drag the file onto a page in SMART Notebook
